

Roof for two new classrooms in an overcrowded school

Project Reference: Ed20_245

► How will this project help?

This secondary school has over 900 students. Grade 1, the youngest class, is very oversubscribed. As a result, their classroom has become overcrowded, and is far too small for the students. The local community recently helped build two new classrooms for grade 1. However, the school lacks the funds to purchase corrugate sheets to construct the roofs. Your support for this project will help improve the learning environment for the students at this school.

► Cost of Project

Costs are given in the local currency, Nepalese Rupees (NRS). This is because all items are bought locally in Nepal to reduce costs and to support the local economy.

Cost breakdown

Corrugated sheets: 5 bundles x 3600 NRS= 18,000 NRS
 Bricks: 1500 x 3 NRS = 4500 NRS
 Cement: 6 sacks x 450 NRS=2700 NRS
 Skilled labour = 3000 NRS
 Project Implementation costs = 3500 NRS
 Local bank charges to receive funds = 350 NRS
 Local Contribution: Unskilled labour = 2000 NRS

Total cost of project in local currency
 = 32050 Nepalese Rupees

► **Total Cost of Project in Pounds =** **267.0833**

(JustAid is currently using an exchange rate of £1 = 120 Nepalese Rupees. This rate is slightly lower than the Banks because it allows for fluctuation in the rates)

► Nepal Factfile

- ◆ Population: 23.1 million
- ◆ Average annual income: US\$ 220
- ◆ Often described as the “country of villages” with over 80 % of the population living in over 40,000 villages, some of which are located in remote mountainous regions.
- ◆ Only 28% of the population have access to adequate sanitation
- ◆ Every year 35,000 children still lose their lives due to diarrhea.
- ◆ 76% of adult females are illiterate
