

## Vocational training for rural women

Project Reference: Mi20\_534

### ► How will this project help?

In this rural area of Nepal, local women have few opportunities to learn new skills. The community has identified fabric painting as a useful way for women to generate an income. This project aims to train thirty women, who will then go on to paint fabric for the local community. Your support for this project will help provide women with the skills needed to generate a sustainable income.

### ► Cost of Project

Costs are given in the local currency, Nepalese Rupees (NRS). This is because all items are bought locally in Nepal to reduce costs and to support the local economy.

#### **Cost breakdown**

Fabric Paints 60 pcs x 100NRS =6000 NRS  
 Materials 30 meters 150NRS =4500 NRS  
 Brush small 30 x40 NRS =1200 NRS  
 Brush big 30 x 50=1500 NRS  
 Camel 30 pcsx40= 1200 NRS  
 Frame 30x 100nrs=3000 NRS  
 Ball pen 30x20=600 NRS  
 Note book 30x40=1200 NRS  
 Tea and snacks 30 person x30 for 7 days=6300  
 Trainers salary for whole training 4000=4000  
 Implementation Cost 3450 (Draft, Courier and Implementation cost)

Total cost of project in local currency =  
 32950 Nepalese Rupees

### ► Total Cost of Project in Pounds = **274.5833**

(JustAid is currently using an exchange rate of £1 = 120 Nepalese Rupees. This rate is slightly lower than the Banks because it allows for fluctuation in the rates)

### ► Nepal Factfile

- ◆ Population: 23.1 million
- ◆ Average annual income: US\$ 220
- ◆ Often described as the “country of villages” with over 80 % of the population living in over 40,000 villages, some of which are located in remote mountainous regions.
- ◆ Only 28% of the population have access to adequate sanitation
- ◆ Every year 35,000 children still lose their lives due to diarrhea.
- ◆ 76% of adult females are illiterate
